

Group Policy & Information

Check In: Before unloading the bus, the group leader must check in with the Event Coordinator and complete the payment process inside the The Shops (main white building).



Drop-off: Please unload only in designated areas (see diagram). For safety reasons, all students must remain on the bus until greeted by a Nature's Art team member.

Late Arrival: We cannot guarantee staff or program/activity availability for late arrivals. Please plan to arrive 10 minutes before your designated start time to complete check-in.

Nature's Art doesn't have a cafeteria for group use.



Picnic areas are available.

Ice cream may be pre-ordered at a group rate. Please ask for a menu. All orders must be placed at least one week prior to your visit.

A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve your date. In the event of inclement weather, the deposit may be applied toward a future visit.



A confirmed final headcount is required no later than one week prior to your visit. If more than 10% of the confirmed guests do not attend, you will still be charged for those absent guests.

Full payment is required before entry into the park. We accept cash, checks (made payable to "Nature's Art"), and credit cards (MasterCard, Visa, Discover).

We will only process one single transaction per group. To receive the group rate, all group members must be present at check-in. Any group members who arrive late will need to pay separately and enter through the public gate.

Group Policy & Information



Groups are not permitted to shop in the gift shop at the entrance/exit to The Dinosaur Pace due to the size of the building.

Please notify us in advance if you plan to visit The Shops so we can have appropriate staffing to serve you.

All students must be accompanied by adult chaperones while in The Shops.

Nature's Art Village will assign your group a specific time for Splashpad use. Depending on your group size, you may be divided into multiple time slots. If you have a time-of-day preference, please let us know in advance—we'll do our best to accommodate it. Each group will receive equal time on the Splashpad. **Group leaders are required to supervise children within the fenced-in area at all times.**



Footwear is required on the Splashpad. Guest must bring and wear your own flip-flops, crocs, or water shoes to participate. Changing areas are available. Children who are not potty-trained must wear a waterproof diaper. **The Splashpad will close in the event of inclement weather.**



*** Socks are required on the T-Rex Tower.**

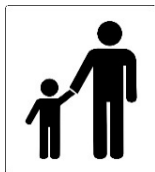
- * For children ages 2-11, weighing under 110 lbs only.
- * Large groups may be split into smaller groups and assigned designated times for this attraction.

The T-Rex Tower will close in the event of inclement weather



- * Sunscreen
- * Water
- * Bathing Suit
- * Waterproof Diaper (required for children not potty-trained, on Splashpad)
- * Water shoes (crocs or flip-flops are permitted)
- * Socks - children without socks will not be able on the T-Rex Tower
 - * Sneakers - for the trails
 - * First aid kit (for group)

Group Policy & Information



One group leader is admitted to the Outdoor Adventure at no cost.

Chaperones must stay with students at all times and are responsible for the safety of their students and the exhibits they visit.

Nature's Art team members are not responsible for the behavior of the children



The bathrooms located across from the Splashpad are suitable for groups.

The bathrooms by the park entrance cannot accommodate groups and should not be used except in an emergency.



Wide-wheeled wheelchairs are recommended for outdoor areas due to graveled terrain. Narrow wheels may have difficulty navigating these surfaces.



At this time, Lapilli Landing (putt-putt, pedal cars & train) cannot accommodate groups and is not included in your admission price
